You may have noticed the survey staking on the course. This is showing the proposed waterline location.

The County is paying for a required archaeology reconnaissance survey to determine if any archaeological resources will be impacted. The study should be done in early July and then out for review for another 30 days. If more study is necessary after that, test holes will be done along this route.

Don't hold your breath for getting water from this additional source this summer. The grounds crew will be busy trying to keep the course playable as the summer heats up. Patience and persistence.

Reminder: Repair your ball marks on the green. Many people don't realize that a ball mark can cause the grass to die, leaving a pit on the putting surface and a nasty scar that can knock your putts offline. If you aren't sure how to repair a mark—ask at the Pro Shop.
