However, the grounds crew has been shorthanded, which has added to the challenge of keeping the course playable.

Unfortunately, there is not much progress to report on the additional waterline. Until the exact location of the waterline running from the storage tank to the course is settled, the archaeological reconnaissance survey cannot be started. A new route now being considered by the County could save them about \$100,000 in the cost of construction. That savings is worth a few extra weeks delay but it's important that we don't miss another summer without the additional million gallons per month. That additional water is critical in making essential improvements and keeping the entire course in good condition for the long-term.
