

Message From Board President, Dan Durow

The annual meeting of The Dalles Country Club took place on February 4th with about 15 members in attendance aside from the five Board members. The 2023 Board of Directors was elected and include; Susan Eddy, Bill Maske, Bill Ferderer, Rex Tegen, Stacy Alleman, Mindy McHale, and Dan Durow. The Officers for the 2023 Board will be elected at the March meeting.

The 2023 budget was presented and discussed in some detail including the estimates for City of The Dalles water use and projected cost. In anticipation of the estimates for this year, the public green fees and cart fees were raised to cover about half of the additional cost along with an increase in membership dues of five percent, or \$9.50 per month for general members. These increases begin March 1st. The estimated cost of City water, based upon using 7 million gallons, is \$26,000 for 2023.

The schedule for getting water from the City has slipped a little but the hope is to see first water by the end of May; fingers crossed.

Some concerns were raised regarding public play and just who qualifies for public play. This is a complicated issue, the policies are not clear, and the enforcement has not been consistent. So, an agenda item will be included the March agenda and a full discussion of this will take place. If you have any comments about this, please be at the meeting or provide written comments to the Board ahead of the meeting.

For the most part this winter, the course has been available for play and warmer weather is on its way. Get out and enjoy your club...and participate to help it succeed.
