City Waterline Progress

Crestline Construction will begin the project construction on September 5th! They will start at the driveway of the truck farm in the Highway 30 right-of-way, then north to the point where the waterline will enter the golf club property. This section will take about a week to complete. Then they will enter the Club property just behind the ninth tee box and then straight to the pond. This section is now scheduled for September 14th to September 19th and will take about four days to complete. This hole (9 & 18) will be closed during the four-day work period. It is anticipated that they will not work on Saturday and Sunday during the Braves and Princesses golf tournament.

Building the potable waterline and pressure pump from the connection at the pond to the Clubhouse is going to be more expensive than (I) first thought. The Board will consider this project during the budget process, but it will most likely not happen until 2025. The permit for doing this work will expire in July of 2025. The work must begin before that or we will have to start all over again with the permitting process.






