A note from the grounds crew:

As you have noticed we have incurred some Snow Mold spots on our greens. This will not permanently damage our greens but is unsightly and affects play on the greens. We actively and regularly treat our greens with granular fungicide and hand spray active outbreaks. Snow Mold is active at temperatures just above freezing in moist conditions. Our weatherconditions so far this year are making our greens a smorgasbord for these molds. On top of that due to the mild conditions we have increased play which tends to spread the mold spores. Normally at this time of year our greens are resting, and traffic is reduced due to freezing and or snow conditions. Please be patient as we are working on this.

Did you know? members can play reciprocal golf courses?
