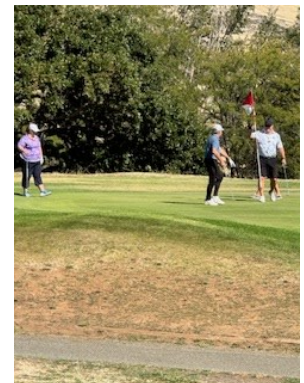
BRAVES AND PRINCESSES TOURNAMENT SUCCESSFUL AND FUN
