Public Play Pricing:

Myself and board members have been getting a lot of questions regarding our public play pricing. At The Dalles Country Club, our pricing structure reflects our unique status as a 501(c)(7) nonprofit, member-based organization. As a semi-private social club, we are governed by a charter and IRS guidelines that require the majority of our revenue to come directly from our members. This means our pricing is intentionally designed to encourage and prioritize membership rather than public or guest play. Maintaining this structure is not just a preference—it is a requirement to preserve our non-profit status and the tax benefits that allow us to operate affordably for our members.

By keeping our course primarily member-funded, we ensure that decisions about operations, improvements, and amenities are made with our membership's best interests in mind. Membership dues help us maintain course quality, support events, and continue offering a private golf experience that's accessible to our community. We understand that green fees and event pricing may seem high at first glance, but these rates are set strategically to uphold our commitment to members and to fulfill the legal and financial obligations tied to our nonprofit status. We invite anyone who enjoys the course and its community to consider joining as a member, supporting not just great golf—but the long-term sustainability of the club itself.

With that in mind, please remember that public play is important to us. Also, an increase in Business Members means many of their guests will be frequenting the course. Let's set a good example of top-notch members' conduct and treat everyone with respect and kindness.

Conduct Reminder from the bylaws we all agree to:

Non-conforming Behavior

Non-conforming behavior shall be handled by the Membership Committee to determine the severity and recommended action to be taken. Recommended action will be referred to the Board of Directors for final action. A member who has been given a warning or other action may appeal to the Board of Directors. The Board, at its discretion, may suspend or terminate any or all privileges of members whose conduct constitutes non-conforming behavior. Continued failure to conform may result in expulsion and the membership shall be canceled. The Procedures for Policy Infractions shall govern actions regarding non-conforming behavior.

Non- conforming behavior is, but not limited to the following:

Failure to comply with the Dress Code.

Loud and/or abusive language, Disorderly conduct such as fighting, loud and boisterous actions, Socially unacceptable conduct.

Failure to comply with Clubhouse or Golf Shop rules, regulations, polices, and Club By-laws. Undue noise or boisterous conduct is not permitted at any time on Club property. Food or beverage brought into the Clubhouse or on the course.

Flagrant non-conforming behavior:

Flagrant non-conforming behavior shall be handled by the Board of Directors to determine the severity and to recommend what action will be taken. Behavior deemed as flagrant will skip the first two levels of action on the Procedures for Policy Infractions. Behavior deemed as seriously flagrant will skip the first three levels of action on the Procedures for Policy Infractions. Once the Membership Committee has determined the violation as flagrant or seriously flagrant, the Committee will verbally, or by mail, inform the member(s) of the recommendation being referred to the Board for its final action.

Pool Conditions for end of June and July

We recognize that the pool conditions regarding the pool surface have less than ideal with black algae.

We are actively working with Maupin Stove and Spa and reteaching staff appropriate chemical management.

Thank you to John Holland for his help with brushing the pool.

The Dolphin pool cleaner has worked great at keeping debris out of the pool.

I am optimistic we will get this black algae situation sorted, shortly.
